Leading biologists and researchers from around the world will be presenting - including our founder, Dr. Lynn Rogers.

A variety of presentations will highlight topics from Minnesota's Arrowhead region, including the "Relationship Between Wolves and Black Bears" by Dr. Lynn Rogers, "Wolves brush with extinction on Isle Royale" by Dr. Rolf Peterson, "Contrasts in the Languages of Wolves and Black Bears" by Dr. Lynn Rogers and Susan Mansfield, "Sigurd Olson's Research in the BWCA" by Douglas Wood, and colorful stories from Dr. L David Mech's 55-year career of researching wolves in Superior National Forest and around the world. Additional presentations will be made by notable researchers from around the world, including Russia's leading polar bear and wolf expert, Nikita Osyankov; Yellowstone National Park's wolf biologist Doug Smith; and Croatia's leading wildlife biologist Josip Kusak.

The North American Bear Center will receive 20% of registration fees from anyone who signs up through our special registration link below. The program will begin at 8:30 a.m. at the Duluth Entertainment Convention Center with sessions concluding at noon. Attendees are welcome to stay and observe the International Union for the Conservation of Nature meeting that will be held from 1:00-3:30 p.m. featuring leading researchers from more than a dozen countries.
